About the Speakers:

Lee Strobel, *Board Member, Willow Creek Association/Teaching Pastor, Saddleback Church*

Former atheist Lee Strobel is an award-winning author, sought-after speaker, and teaching pastor at Saddleback Church, where he regularly speaks to the 15,000 seekers and Christians who visit each weekend. With a degree from Yale Law School, Lee was legal editor of *The Chicago Tribune* before his conversion in 1981. His books include two Gold Medallion winners: *Inside the Mind of Unchurched Harry & Mary* and *The Case for Christ*, which hit #1 on the Christian best seller list. Other books include *The Case For Faith*, *God's Outrageous Claims* and *What Jesus Would Say*. He is a founding board member of the Willow Creek Association, a network of 5,000 churches striving to communicate Christianity to spiritual seekers, and host of *Defining Moments*, a monthly audio journal for church leaders.

Mark Mittelberg, *Executive Vice President, Willow Creek Association*

Mark Mittelberg has earned his Masters degree in Philosophy of Religion from Trinity in Deerfield, Illinois and a Bachelor's degree in Business Management from Minot State University in North Dakota. Mark has co-authored the book *Becoming a Contagious Christian* with Bill Hybels, and he is a contributing editor to *The Journey*, an NIV reference Bible designed especially for spiritual seekers. In the past Mark served seven years as a ministry director and seminar teacher at Willow Creek Community Church. Currently Mark is Executive Vice President of the Willow Creek Association, a network of over 5,000 churches around the world that share the goal of reaching people who have doubts and questions, and helping them become followers of Christ.

Q&A Instructions

You may ask Lee and Mark questions at any point during the broadcast. There are three ways to submit questions: Phone, Fax, Email. Your site coordinator should inform you of how they are choosing to submit your questions to us.

There are a couple important things to keep in mind when submitting your questions:

- Please write legibly so they can be easily read
- If you would like to remain anonymous, you can simply leave off your name and just give us the city and state you are in or nothing at all.

Important Information About Calling In Your Question:

If you choose to call in your question during the Live Q&A portion of the program, there are some guidelines that must be followed in order for us to allow you to ask your question live and in person. You must be calling from a regular phone (no cell phones, please) in another part of the building. We need you to be sure that you can not even hear the slightest noise from the broadcast, otherwise we will experience feedback. When you call in, you will be put on hold, and will be able to hear the broadcast. This way you will not miss anything while being out of the room. (Note: If you do not wish to ask your question in person, just let them know when you call. You can also call in during the regular portion of the broadcast and dictate your question to be answered later during the Q&A portion)

Important Information About Faxing In Your Question:

When you are faxing in your question, keep in mind that others may be doing the same thing at the same time. Therefore, you may experience busy signals. You can keep trying or email us instead.

Important Information About Emailing In Your Question:

Emailing your question is the easiest and fastest way to get us your question. You will not have to dictate it, and you will not experience any busy signals.
