Your personal glimpse of God

Look to His Word and to His world

*As a bridegroom rejoices over his bride,
so will your God rejoice over you*
—Isaiah 62:5

Recognize the breathtaking splendor of His creation

Know that all of the good you see in other people is
reflections of God who created us in His image.

^{6b}*Hallelujah! For the Lord our God, the
Almighty, reigns. Let us be glad and
rejoice and honor him. ⁷For the time has
come for the wedding feast of the Lamb...
and his bride has made herself ready.*

Open God’s love letter to you and approach each day with
great anticipation

⁸*She is permitted to wear the finest white
linen.” (Fine linen represents the good
deeds done by the people of God.) ⁹And
the angel said, “Write this: Blessed are
those who are invited to the wedding
feast of the Lamb.”*
—Revelation 19:6-9

Inhale His revelations

Baptism

A *mikvah* is a body of water emanating from a natural source, such as a spring

- The amount of water must equal 40 seah (a biblical unit of measure)
- 40 signifies the number of days it takes for a fetus to attain human form
- The mikvah is the womb; we are “reborn” when we are lifted out of the water

John’s intention with baptism was to prepare us,
the bride of Christ, for our wedding day!

“The bride belongs to the bridegroom. The friend who attends the bridegroom waits and listens for him, and is full of joy when he hears the bridegroom’s voice. That joy is mine, and is now complete.”
—John 3:29

Communion

The wine glass symbolizes a marriage proposal.

Jesus said, “Don’t be troubled. You trust God, now trust in me. ²There are many rooms in my Father’s home, and I am going to prepare a place for you. If this were not so, I would tell you plainly. ³When everything is ready, I will come and get you, so that you will always be with me where I am.”
—John 14:1-3

God wants to turn our Sin story into a success story.

Redemption of our past

God didn’t overlook sin. He *forgave* it. He *cleansed* it. He *redeemed* it.

Justified means “just-if-I’d *never* done those things!”

Our memories can be spiritual **markers**
of how far God has brought us

God’s redemptive power can turn *your* greatest misery into your greatest ministry as well

Resurrection power for today

The bride of Christ has the Holy Spirit to be our personal **counselor**.

This same Spirit in Jesus is now in us!

Truths about Satan:

- He is not the evil counterpart to God. His power is limited
- Satan's legion is one-third the size of God's angels that protect you
- Satan is not omniscient like God
- Satan is also not omnipresent

⁹I no longer count on my own goodness or my ability to obey God's law, but I trust Christ to save me. For God's way of making us right with himself depends on faith. ¹⁰As a result I can really know Christ and experience the mighty power that raised him from the dead. I can learn what it means to suffer with him, sharing in his death, ¹¹so that, somehow, I can experience the resurrection from the dead! ¹²i don't mean to say that I have already achieved these things or that I have already reached perfection! But I keep working toward that day when I will finally be all that Christ Jesus saved me for and wants me to be.
—Philippians 3:9-12
